ABIDE Acrostic

- (I) A Awareness (vs 1-2) What is Jesus revealing to us?
 - o Hearers not bearing fruit are being taken away.
 - o Hearers bearing fruit are being pruned to bear more fruit.
- (II) B Believe (vs 3-5) Am I believing what Jesus says?
 - o You are already <u>clean</u> because you believe what He says.
 - o You are already clean because the Word is sanctifying you.
- (III) I Invest (vs 6-8) How am I spending His time?
 - o Jesus describes those that are not connected.
 - o Our closeness reflects His words and values in our communication.
- (IV) D Deepen (vs 9-15) Do I resemble Jesus in obedience and love?
 - o If I obey Jesus' commandments, my union with Him produces joy!
 - o If I love Jesus, I will love my neighbor with the same <u>affection</u> He displayed when He took my sin to the cross.
- (V) E Engage (vs 16-17) Here I am LORD! I give up my way Send me!
 - o Jesus has chosen and appointed me to abide I give up my way.
 - o Pruning <u>yields</u> love for Christ, the body, and the world!

1. Awareness

- a. How have I allowed distractions to steal my attention? How do they distract me from my identity in Christ?
- b. What type of Christian am I living as?

2. Believe

- a. What lies am I believing right now? How do they distract my faith?
- b. Do I believe what Jesus says about His work for me on the cross?

 If so, how has that given me confidence?

3. Invest

- a. What distractions are stealing time away from my being close to Jesus?
- b. Why is healthy communication a key in spiritual transformation?
- c. How am I investing the time He has given me?

4. Deepen

- a. What are His commandments? (Matthew 22:37-39) Do I obey His commandments?
- b. How do I love my neighbor like Jesus did?

5. Engage

- a. What distractions is Jesus asking me to surrender?
- b. What fruit am I bearing in this process of ABIDE? (Galatians 5:22-23)
